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# Guidelines for the Preparation of a Manuscript for ISFS 2008

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**Abstract:** This paper provides guidelines for the preparation of manuscripts for the Second Joint Congress on Intelligent and Fuzzy Systems (ISFS 2008) to be held at MUT in October 2008. This paper itself is an example of the desired format. Formats for Equations, Tables and References are also presented.

**Keywords:** Conference publication format, guide to authors.

The paper title should be typed with the first character in every word in capital letters, centred and placed 28 mm from the top of the first page. The title should be bold printed and should not be underlined. The name(s) of the author(s) and author affiliation(s) should be centred, with the first character in every word in capital letters. In the end of the title block and after the author affiliation(s) the author's e-mail address must be written.

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## 1 Introduction

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It is our aim to produce uniform conference proceedings. We would therefore appreciate it very much if you would prepare your paper in accordance with the following guidelines. Papers will not be accepted for process if they are not prepared in accordance with the required format.

Proportional-spaced fonts (e.g. Roman or equivalent) should be used in the main body text. Please try to avoid using mono-spaced fonts (e.g. Courier). Font sizes are specified in Table 1.

## 2 Format

Each manuscript is to be submitted electronically in pdf format through the ISFS 2008 Online Conference Management System (<http://isfs.mut-es.ac.ir>). It is limited to six pages. Your paper should be submitted on A4 (210 mm x 297 mm) page and typed in a two-column format as shown in this paper.

### 2.1 Title Block

### 2.2 Keywords and Abstract

The author should select up to five keywords to supplement the title to reflect the subject matter. A meaningful and concise abstract is also required. The abstract should not exceed 200 words.

### 2.3 Headings

All headings should commence at the left-hand margin of the column. Except at the top of a new page, all headings should be numbered and preceded by one blank line.

First and second Order (or Main) Headings. These should be typed with the first character in every word capitalised, boldfaced and followed by one blank line.

## 3 Other Requirements

### 3.1 Figures and Tables

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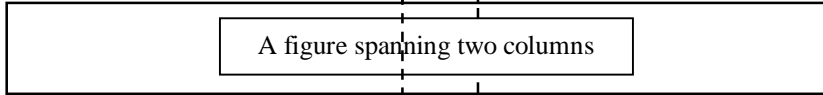
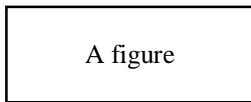


Figure 1: A figure spanning two columns

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Figures and tables can occupy either one or two columns. Figures 1 and 2 are provided as examples of figures.

Equations should be in italics and symbols, and should be clearly numbered. Reference to the equations should be in the form of "Equation (2)". For example, Equation (1) is Nobody's Law.

$$\int_x^5 (X_\rho + y_l)^2 dz = \frac{dy}{dx} \quad (1)$$

Citation of the references should be made within square brackets. For example, book reference [1] and other references [2, 3] are listed at the end of the paper.
